Notes

- 1) A portion of your membership fees goes to the SASA and the East District, mostly to cover insurance costs.
- 2) If both parents are likely to volunteer to help then they should take out the relevant 2 adult membership (however see note (3) about refund of membership for volunteers).
- 3) Parents who have volunteered a number of times through the year will be offered a refund of the parental portion of the family membership fee at the discretion of the executive. This ensures those who contribute their time to the club are not disadvantaged financially, and those that are unable to volunteer their time contribute more financially to the club.
- 4) A child swimmer is defined as under 16 the year of membership. A child member is not entitled to vote at general meetings. Adults are defined as 16 and over.
- 5) Family membership entitles parent members to voting rights at general meetings.
- 6) Student members must be registered on a course at a higher education establishment and provide their matriculation number and a letter of proof of their student status.
- 7) No lapsed member may participate in any activities of the club or for the club in competitions until the subscription has been paid.
- 8) By our constitution, details of those admitted to membership may be held on computer(s) unless the member requests otherwise. Such personal data shall be disclosed only within the club or to the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association (SASA). Members wishing to resign must have sent formal notice to the Honorary Secretary before the Annual General Meeting; otherwise they are liable for the ensuing year's subscription.
- 9) Members joining at least half way through the years may be offered a deduction in annual member's fee at the discretion of the executive.
