Extract from SASA Bye Laws

Category 1 - A member 7 years and under (as at 31st March) who is learning to swim prior to becoming a Category 2 Member. An individual can only register twice in this category.

Category 2 - A member 10 years and under (as at 31st March) or synchro grades 1 & 2 and novice divers who participates in any aquatic activity.

Category 3 - A members 16 years and over who is a technical official, teacher, coach, club helper, committee member or a volunteer in any discipline and does not participate in any aquatic activity.

SASA Reg. STO - Ticking the box is stating your wish to be a SASA Registered STO.

Category 4 - A member over the age of 10 years, excluding synchro grades 1 & 2 and novice divers who participates in any aquatic activity.

Eligibility

Extract from Company Rules R.13.5.3(c)

"c) satisfy either of the following residential criteria:

i) for the Commonwealth Games -

In line with current Commonwealth Games Federation Regulations or Guidelines." (see Information Guide for details).

ii) for all other events –

a person who has been a resident in Scotland for a minimum of six months in the 12 months prior to the first day of competition."

Note:- certificates are needed for all categories above. If qualified under 2. above, please enclose a copy of your parent's birth certificate and in case of qualification through your mother, marriage certificate. Applications will not be accepted without necessary certificates. Qualification under 3. above must satisfy the Board of Directors. Please note that category 3. above entitles members to represent Scotland at competitions other than the Commonwealth Games.
